## THE PORTLAND STREETCAR LOOP

The **Portland Streetcar Loop Project** in Portland, Oregon, will be a 3.3-mile extension of the existing and highly-successful Portland Streetcar Project, which was constructed using all local funds. The Portland Streetcar Loop Project will extend streetcar tracks, stations, and service from the Pearl District in NW Portland, across the existing Broadway Bridge, serving the eastern half of the Portland Central City.

The Portland Streetcar Loop Project's streetcars will serve 28 new streetcar stops. Later, as a separate project, the Loop will be completed via a new bridge at the south end, allowing continuous connections around the entire Loop.

### Highlights

- Extends the existing Westside Portland Streetcar Project
- Increases project area housing units to meet goals outlined in Central City Plan
- Attracts 2.4 million square feet of new development into the project area
- Transports 3.5 million new riders per year beginning 2011
- Reduces regional vehicle miles traveled by 28 million miles per year
- Creates no significant environmental impacts
- Achieves and supports regional and local transit, environmental, and economic development goals

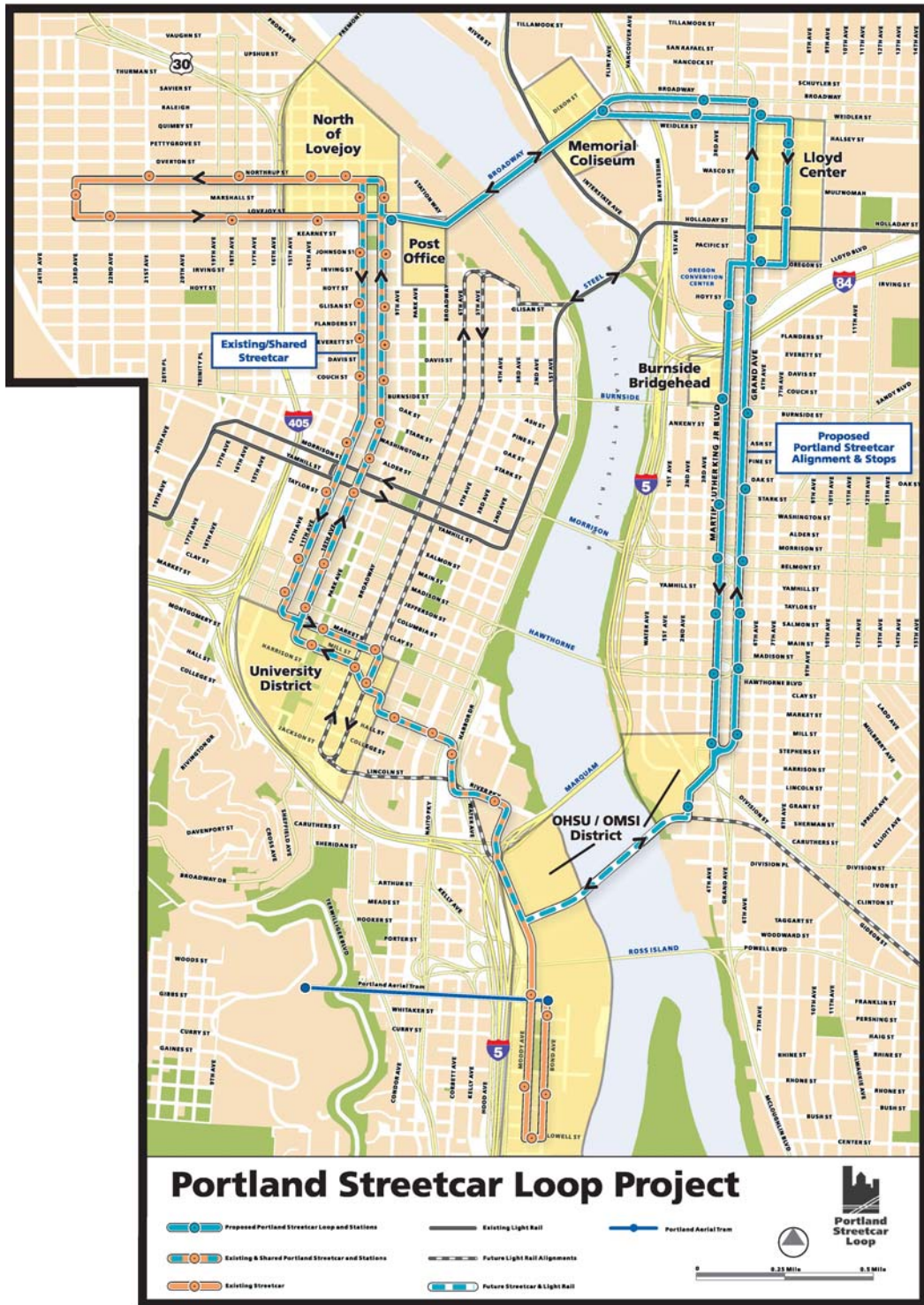
